



## **Work You Can Do At Home! Have a Go!**

*Please don't worry if you cannot complete all of the work below! Try your best and you will have lots of questions for your teacher when you return to school.*

### **Junior Room:**

- Ms. Kennedy sent home booklets which could be completed at home by both the **Junior and Senior Infant Classes**.
- First Class were supplied with a list of activities that could be completed using their school books and/or worksheets.

### **Middle Room:**

- Children in the Middle Room (2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Class) have been given a list of activities that they can complete in their books and/or worksheets.
- Children wrote this list in their homework diaries and it has also been sent to parents through the ClassDojo.

### **Senior Room:**

- **Mathematics:**
  - All children will have assignments to do on the online Mathletics Programme and these will be monitored and updated as necessary.
  - Students could revise all chapters that have been completed in their Busy at Maths books. Children should repeat 2 or 3 questions from all sections within the chapters.
  - As always children should practice their addition, subtraction, multiplication and division tables regularly.

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- **English:**
  - **Spellings:** 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> should complete weeks 24, 25 and 26.
  - **Let's Go (4<sup>th</sup> Class):**
    - Read pages 134-141 (*The Bravest March*) and complete as many exercises as you can from pages 142-143.
    - Read pages 144-147 (*Polar Exploration*) and complete as many exercises as you can from pages 148-149.
  - **Racing Ahead (5<sup>th</sup>/6<sup>th</sup> Class):**
    - Read pages 144-151 (*The Bush Fire*) and complete as many exercises as you can from pages 152-153.
    - Read pages 154-157 (*Fire*) and complete as many exercises as you can from pages 158-159.
  - **My Read at Home:** Children can read pages 67-74.
  - **Reading Express:** Children can continue to engage in lessons and activities on the online Reading Express programme.
  
- **Gaeilge:**
  - **Bua na Cainte:** Children could read from pages 187-194 and complete any exercises that they are able to do.
  - Children have the option of creating their own Comic Strip story in Irish.
  - Students could also be encouraged to watch Irish Programmes on Cúla4.
  
- **History:**
  - Children could read Chapter 12 in their History Quests (*The Changes the Normans Brought to Ireland*). As a response, students could create a PowerPoint Presentation on this topic.

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- **Geography:**
  - Students could read Chapter 14 in their Geography Quests (*The Fishing Industry in Ireland*). Children could complete any activities that they are able to from this chapter.
- **Project Work:** I would encourage the Senior Room Students to research and create a project on a topic of their choosing. This should be done on an area that really interests the children. The project could be completed as a PowerPoint Presentation, on chart paper or on a scrap book.
